SAMPLE ITINERARY

DAY 1: - D

Our gorgeous Girls and Pearls Safari – please let us know your flight details. Best flight is possibly QF581 via Perth from Sydney with arrival into Broome airport at 5.50pm. (Please note direct Sydney flights run Tuesday and Saturday; Melbourne on Wednesdays) You'll be picked up by the lovely resort staff and taken to the hotel for check-in and a welcome drink. (if you arrive earlier the resort will also come and get you)

We'll all meet for cocktails around 6.30pm and move on to a relaxed dinner at the resort's Brizo Garden Grill. Meeting us tonight is the very charming general manager of Pinctada Michael Hughes who is full of local knowledge of Broome and its history and ideas to make your stay perfect. (by the way, all our activities are written up on a blackboard next to reception so you'll always know what's happening).

We will tuck you into bed before it gets too late - remember the time difference makes that first day seem very long!

DAY 2: - B, D

Start the day early if you wish with a stretch/yoga class or walk along the fabulous Cable Beach...or sleep in. Enjoy a European breakfast buffet (including a hot dish)

We start by hitting the red dirt and heading out of town to see a working pearl farm and learning a little of the history of where we are and more about those perfect pearls – the tears of the moon.

Return to the resort to relax by the pool and prepare to get really pampered – we have an afternoon of spa treatments waiting for us – if you haven't already booked your treatments, please contact the spa. (booking form and menu in previous email).

Later in the day we'll show you around the town of Broome and some of the sights so you'll know where all the special places are to visit during your stay.

Dinner tonight is a banquet dinner at the heritage McAlpine House, an exceptional huge estate also owned by Marilynne Paspaley. Local gallery owner Belinda Cornish will join us for dinner.

DAY 3: - B, L, drinks and snacks with the moonrise, D

Start the day with a gentle yoga class or walk or sleep. Enjoy a European buffet breakfast.

You can book into a spa and beauty session if you like or relax by the pool or walk/shuttle to Cable Beach. Shuttle into town for the vibrant morning markets which are full of great finds. We also have a list of good places to visit as well.

Back to the resort to kick off our shoes, hang out by the pool and relax.

Late afternoon we will head down to Roebuck Bay ready to watch the moon rise and create the Staircase to the Moon. Of course we'll accompany this beautiful phenomenon with champagne and something delicious. Then we will stroll across the road for dinner at Matso's, Broome's boutique micro brewery which is fun and serves good food.

DAY 4: - B, snack at pearl showroom, early evening cocktails and canapés, supper.

Yoga, walk or sleep then join us for a European breakfast buffet.

Late morning we are doing the pearl things – a private "pearl appreciation session" at the Paspaley Boutique.

You'll get the chance to try the delicate delights of pearl meat (similar to abalone), which goes so well with champagne. You'll also be able to try on as many pearls as you wish and choose what you'd like to wear for the Cinderella dinner.

In the afternoon we step into the picture postcard with a glorious Champagne of the Sand with delicious treats from the Pinctada kitchen...then as the sunset starts to reveal all its many beautiful colours, we'll be riding camels along that perfect stretch of sand...the people are wonderful at taking pics on your own camera – this is one image you'll want to keep!

Then as it gets dark, we head to the beautiful old outdoor picture theatre Sun Pictures for a special viewing of Bran Nue Dae, the musical filmed in Broome. Sun Pictures is the oldest continuously operating outdoor movie house in Australia and Marilynne has organised for this great film to be shown tonight especially for us. Its great being able to look up at the stars while you watch a movie! Supper back at Pinctada by the pool.

DAY 5: - B, D

Start the day with some activity (yoga class) or none...followed by European breakfast buffet

Just after breakfast we will head into town to meet up with gallery owner Belinda Cornish to have a private viewing of the work in her marvelous gallery... - and we've also arranged a visit with one of the other local galleries who will spend time with the group.

Tonight is our Cinderella evening – we will all be golden, glowing, relaxed and wearing the world's best pearls...push the pause button girls – it doesn't get better than this! We will indulge in a formal Gorgeous Gala Dinner at Selene Brasserie featuring a menu designed by one of my favourite chefs – the legendary Greg Malouf.

DAY 6: - B
